







the back-to-school dinner (15 September)


- the FLG benefit dinner (11 October)



Retirement Committee


Inflation continues, we only have to think about our grocery basket, rent, energy. This year, the AIRR (annualized pension indexation rate) is 4.4%. This means that the QPP will be increased by 4.4% on January 1, 2024. Our RSP, RRCE, RPPE, RREGOP pensions will be increased by

4.4% for the portion of the pension contributed before 1982,1.4% for the portion of the pension contributed between 1982 and 1999.2.2% for the portion of the pension contributed after January 1, 2000

The battle for the full indexation of our pensions continues. A clause in the 2010 agreement provides for an increase in the pension for the years 1982 to 1999 if the funding rate of the RREGOP reaches 120%. The good news is that in October, a rate of 123.1% was reached.

In August, RREGOP members will receive a lump sum payment of 0.8% on the portion of the pension corresponding to the years 1982-1999. This amount will be retroactive to January 1, 2024. For EPP, ECPP and PPMP recipients, a decision is still to be made by July 1, 2024.










Lunch of the Month


On the first Friday of the month, many of us socialize with colleagues in the sector.

She mentioned the link with the MELS program for culture and citizenship in Quebec.




Activities to be planned in 2023 - 2024

We will soon be ordering pins that we will need for **March 8, 2024**, **International Women's Day**. More details will follow.


