



A word from the President




Hello,





We look forward to seeing you.












Our committee has been very active in the last period of the year 2023-2024.

Three main activities marked this stage. We cannot ignore the following:

- The day of March 8. About sixty women celebrated hard won Women's Rights around a festive table in Montreal. We have strengthened our ties and felt that we were united in these times of global and local turbulence. We were there, very much alive and imbued with the generous gestures that many of us do every day.
- An exceptional meeting was held on May 16 with Ms. Pauline Marois, the first woman to have been **Premier of Quebec.** Our speaker was able to hold the audience by reminding us that she was a social worker, a mother and a wife at a time when there were few women who reached positions of governance. She has been able to shape Quebec, if only through the daycare centers that allow greater autonomy to mothers in today's society.
- May 14 was a day of visits to BAnQ's National Archives in Montreal. A friend of mine who was a volunteer from BAnQ was our guide. She told us about the importance of the 1910 heritage building, which houses a large number of valuable heritage documents that are accessible to the public while ensuring their preservation. A sculpture from 1907, **The Giants of Saint-Jacques Street**, fascinated us all. Many have learned that BAnQ publishes À *Rayons ouverts*, which presents archival documents that recall our Quebec history twice a year. To be obtained if you want them. 
On Sunday, June 9, thousands of people attended the Formula 1 Grand Prix at the Circuit Gilles-Villeneuve; They paid dearly to enrich the racing moguls.

That same Sunday afternoon, nearly 150 people participated in the Bowl-a-thon and enriched the Laure-Gaudreault Foundation while having fun. Indeed, a record for donations was set: \$5,500 was given as part of the 2024 regional collection, eclipsing last year's previous record (\$5035).

I would like to thank all the people who put their time and energy into recruiting participants. I also thank the members who led this activity: if there was rain outside, inside it was the radiant sun and friendship that warmed the bowlers.

After five years, I can say "mission accomplished": \$18,114 has been donated to our foundation and, by the same token, to dozens of community organizations on the island of Montreal through this activity since 2018.

I hope the tradition continues.








After recent changes in our group insurance plan, I think it is relevant to review our basic vocabulary. The disappearance of the ASSUREQ corporation, the SSQ, is it worrisome? What has become of our insurance plan?


A little history. In the past, in our workplace, through our membership in the CSQ central we had insurance coverage. When we retired, we lost those benefits. We were offered an opportunity, to join a retirees' association, namely AREQ, which offered us an insurance plan for the future. We had 90 days to accept this offer and our decision was irrevocable.

Let's clarify a few terms. One day, AREQ, a retirees' association, entered into an agreement with an insurance company, the SSQ, to offer its members a group insurance plan that was given the name ASSUREQ. Let's remember one important thing: to benefit from the plan, you must be a member of AREQ.

Amendments to the ASSUREQ plan are renegotiated annually. AREQ has formed a group responsible for this negotiation with the insurer SSQ. AREQ had the very bad idea of naming this group "the ASSUREQ corporation".

This year, two pieces of news have caused confusion among us. The AREQ has decided to abolish the ASSUREQ corporation and to reclaim the negotiation of the plan's conditions. The ASSUREQ Corporation no longer exists, but ASSUREQ remains the name of our insurance plan. Then, two insurance companies, LA CAPITALE and the SSQ, decided to merge into a single BENEVA company. Only one thing changes for us: instead of making our claims to SSQ, we direct them to BENEVA, the new insurer. The ASSUREQ plan is still exactly the same; Take heart and get used to a new website.





The text of the ASSUREQ Plan is printed in its entirety from time to time. The last printed edition dates from January 2022. In addition, in January of each year, a leaflet informs us of changes in coverage and costs for the new year. And at all times, a full version is available in our BENEVA customer area



Finally, a great novelty for people who gave up these ASSUREQ benefits when they retired and who regret it. All retirees who have been members of a union affiliated with the CSQ for at least **one (1) day** can reconsider their decision and join the AREQ and its ASSUREQ plan. The options available to people who join after the deadline are different, but remain very interesting. People who had coverage with their spouse and lost it, people who regret not having travel insurance anymore, etc. Spread the good news around you. Invite these people to call 1-800-663-2408 ---to find out more about your return to the AREQ and its ASSUREQ (health-life-travel) group insurance plan.





